

Welcome to Mount Edgcumbe at War 2018.

The Cornwall area of the MVT welcome you to our annual show. We hope you will have a good weekend. We aim to have another weekend for all the right reasons! The 1940s

Roadshow will once more provide us with refreshment and entertainment, and we encourage everyone to support them. They play a major part in the overall success of the event.

Blackboards will be placed both at the Roadshow and at the Cornwall area HQ detailing daily events. Water is available on site, but we encourage exhibitors to bring a good supply in the first instance.

Vehicle movement between 1000 and 1630 should be kept to a minimum, and a speed limit of 10mph respected . Road runs will take place at 1015, the short one, and at 1630. There are many visitors to the event, and everyone involved should take care at all times. Please adhere to both local and MVT rules.

The MVT code of conduct can be found at www.mvt.org.uk. Local rules, which it has been proven are needed, are as follows:

1. All military vehicles and tents including period tents such as those from medieval times, must be in the show area or the designated tent area. Not in the camper/caravan/parking field.
2. Civilian tents unless very well camouflaged should be pitched in a separate area a few yards from the camp itself.
3. All civilian vehicles should be parked in the adjacent field as directed by 1000 and remain there until 1700. Groups are encouraged to share vehicles if possible.
4. Civilian motorhomes, caravans, trailer tents and other living vans should be parked in the adjacent field as directed. Individual pitches

will be marked. No tents are permitted in the field due to regular use by livestock. DEFRA regulations we are advised.

5. There will be no exceptions. Those without passes will need to park in the official Mt Edgcumbe car park at the top of the hill.

6. Passes will be issued on arrival to bona fide exhibitors only.

7. NO PASS, NO ENTRY, NO ARGUMENT.

8. The adjacent parking field will cost us several hundred pounds if not more. Without the field we could not put on a show of this type. Cornwall area MVT also have to pay for toilets and a skip for your rubbish which costs about £1000! Therefore we feel that a £5 per night fee for caravans and motorhomes etc is reasonable, and a £2 per day fee for cars would be fair. We will issue you with your parking and caravan passes on arrival, and a tin for fees will be in the reporting tent. Entry to the park is free, so we make no money from the event. We are thankful to MVT HQ for some of the necessary funding.

9. Live firing by reenactment groups will be at a set time as directed by the Queens Harbourmaster Plymouth. Details will be published at the event. No firing at other times.
